

2017 Buck clinic basic participation & deposit information

Buck will be back in Corvallis at the Benton County fairgrounds again on July 7, 8, & 9, 2017. It will be Friday, Saturday, & Sunday this year. Class participation slots have filled, but we have plenty of room for spectators.

Spectator fees (non-class participants) will be \$30. per person per day with 12 & under and 65+ still being complimentary!

This year's classes are:

Foundation Horsemanship: This class is valuable for everyone! During each of the class sessions a portion of the class is dedicated to students working their horse from the ground in preparation for riding, while the rest of the class is horseback. Snaffle bit is encouraged.

25 riders + sponsors

Friday, Saturday, & Sunday 9am sharp - 12noon (AM class)

Horsemanship 1: All levels of riders and horses - no matter what discipline - will benefit from this class. All maneuvers stress the Vaquero style of riding and are appropriate for horses from the first level snaffle to experienced bridle horses. Students ride their own horse.

25 riders + sponsors

Friday, Saturday, & Sunday 1:30-4:30pm (Afternoon class)

Class participation gives you 3 days of 3 hours with your horse and Buck, and 3 hours watching and listening to Buck in the stands during the other class. He truly expects you to be in the stands to continue your learning whether you are in the morning class or the afternoon class. There isn't enough time while you are in the arena to cover all the information he has to share with you. Please remember as a participant you must get out of your comfort level to advance your skills. The more you put into your time in class the more you will get out of it. Buck is more drawn to help those who are working hard at trying to do what he is asking of them.

Should you have interest in being a future clinic participant, costs are listed below:

Class Cost is \$700 per class for 3 hours each of the 3 days. It also includes auditing the other class at this clinic. Becoming a participant starts with a \$200 deposit then class balance of \$500. is due by May 15th, 2017 along with stall and dinner fees.

Stalls are \$75 for (1 day or all 3) with bedding & end of clinic stripping included. Additional days/nights are \$20.00 each.

Camping is \$25 night for Tent or dry, \$35 a night for water and electric, full hookups \$39.50 a night. Tent, horse trailer, RV, etc; (showers available).

Motel special rate will be set up at the Holiday Inn Express ~ Corvallis on the river.

Group dinner - \$15 per person
